

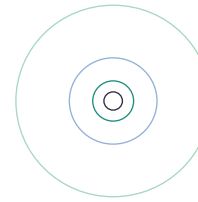

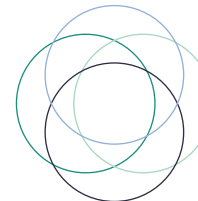

From the first female medical student to the latest Netflix star, our alumnae have been blazing trails since 1876.

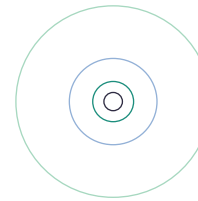


WELLBEING

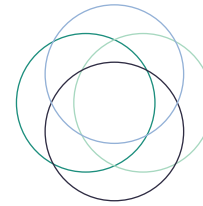

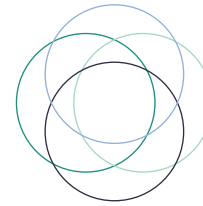

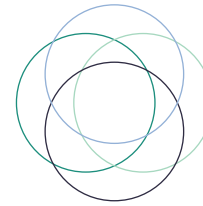
